Buyong Sponsorship Program News 2003

The Buyong Sponsorship Program began in 1982 when Martha Zaiser decided to help Nora Erbito complete her high school education. Starting with this simple goal the BSP quickly expanded to include many more scholarships for deserving students, assistance to the Buyong Elementary School, and projects to improve the overall health and standard of living for residents of Buyong and Maribago.

Over the last twenty years the program has continued to pursue these three main goals. Despite some initial setbacks, we have had many successes, including:

<u>Scholarships:</u> Sixty-two students have gone to high school and/or college as a part of the program. Sixty-seven different individuals, families, school clubs or church groups have participated in this aspect of the program. Graduates of the Buyong Sponsorship Program include industrial and civil engineers, quality control inspectors for a variety of firms, health care workers, teachers, government workers, police, hotel and restaurant employees, dive shop operators, scuba instructors, and even a disc jockey.

<u>School Food Program:</u> The school food program continues to provide a hot meal for every child in the school. Since its inception in 1986 the BES Food Program has distributed more than one and a half million meals.

<u>Medical Program:</u> The BSP supports education and immunization programs at the Maribago Health Center. Our own BSP Medical Program continues to provide education and medicine for Buyong residents with tuberculosis.

<u>Village-wide Projects:</u> Working with the Maribago Barangay Council, the BSP has helped with many community projects, such as:

- Typhoon relief repair and rebuilding of more than fifty houses following a major typhoon
- 2. The establishment of water cooperatives and the construction of communal toilets in four locations
- 3. The development of a trash collection system
- 4. Participation in the barangay "Clean and Green Campaign"
- Assistance for the annual "International Coastal Clean-up"

- 7. Construction at the Datag Daycare Center
- 8. Gravel surfaced Buyong village beach access road
- Laptop computers and instruction for the Maribago Barangay Council
- Continued assistance and support for programs at the Maribago Health Center.
